## Becoming a Member Checklist

### Attend a meeting

- 1<sup>st</sup> Tuesday of every month, 7:30pm at the clubhouse; the club gates will be open, and members will be there to greet you.
- Fill out and submit a waiver for shooting at the club ranges.
- Fill out the pre-application information sheet, membership application, & receive the constitution. (Turn them in together at your 2nd meeting.)
- Learn about the club meetings, business, & introduce yourself during the meeting's "new member starting the process" segment (At the end).

### Get acquainted (complete at least ONE of the following)

- Attend a work party on the Saturday immediately following the club meeting, starting at 9:00am. The gates will be open.
- Aid a club member in an approved clerical task.
- Provide an approved service to the club.
- Attend a club event such as the Critter Gitter, a Novelty Shoot, or an Outdoor Shoot.

### Complete the SCA New Member Introduction class

- The class is scheduled on an as needed basis, generally from 11:30 AM to 1:00 PM on a Saturday or Sunday. At times, the class is held immediately following a Work Party or Critter Gitter.

- There is no charge for this event; come ready to listen. No archery equipment is used during this class.

### Get a sponsor

- You need a club member in good standing for at least a year to sponsor you. Just ask someone when you meet people at the "get acquainted" event you choose.

### Attend another club meeting

- Reintroduce yourself to the members during the meeting's new member segment (At the end).
- Your membership will be voted on by the members.
- Pay dues (cash or check) & key deposit to the treasurer after the meeting & **turn in your completed application to receive your keys.**
