- A. Tyson researched different types and recommends we try Bulldog Targets (bulldogtargets.com). They have a fabric cover, foam faces and proprietary filler that stops arrows and lasts for years. Targets come in a range of sizes: 24" x 48" would work indoors. 36" x 36" would be typical outdoors.
 - B. Discussed various options to try for the indoor and outdoor ranges. Consensus was to replace two columns of bales on the indoor range and one or two outdoor targets.
 - C. Erik moved a budget of \$2500 for targets and shipping, second by Marty. Motion passed with no objections. Tyson to coordinate with Mark and Robin on placing the order.
