Ground Rules for league members:

1. Must have own equipment and archery experience PRIOR to joining.
2. Must commit to coming every week and making up any absences as needed.
3. Membership in SCA is NOT required.
4. Must be an adult or serious youth archer. Archers ages 8 to 12 with parent permission and league committee consent.
5. Must follow all of the range rules, SCA Club By-Laws, tournament rules, and rules of archery etiquette, which will be reviewed in an orientation meeting prior to the first league shoot.

Must shoot the same bowstyle from start to finish in each league. If shooting on two nights you can choose a different bowstyle for the second nig
