4.01 Instructor Club Fees

- A. The current policy for paid classes taught on the indoor range is that \$5 per student goes to the club. Mark asked that we consider amending the policy.

1. Origin of the current fee: It was proposed by Ben Rogers more than 5-years ago. The thought at the time was that if you are using the club's range and equipment for paid lessons, the club should get some compensation for wear and tear on the bales and inconvenience to other members who might want to use the range at the same time.
 2. Some instructors are coaching other club members. Club members are entitled to use the range and equipment since they paid dues.
 3. Classes come in various sizes. Big groups fill the entire indoor range, while small ones can use just a few lanes.
 4. For big groups, you need multiple instructors who split the instructor fees, so a maximum fee per class would be appreciated.
 5. Some fee for the club is merited since there is wear and tear on the bales and equipment.
 6. Does the fee apply to parties/private groups? No, the range is for members and guests. The fee only applies to paid lessons.
 7. Can the entire range be booked for a private event or lesson? Not per the by-laws (you must make a lane available for a member to shoot), but if you show a large event on the calendar, members will typically come back to shoot after a large event rather than concurrently.
- C. The proposed replacement policy is: "For paid archery lessons/coaching on the indoor range, the club shall receive \$5 per non-SCA member student. The range use fee is capped at \$40 per hour (prorated for partial hours) and at \$80 per day. No range use fee is required for students who are SCA members". Moved by Andy/Mark, second by Don, passed 16 Yes, 0 No, 2 abstain.
