1. Opening Items

4.02 How to Join the Club during the shelter in place?

4.03 Poison Oak eradication (Ruth)

- A. There are bad patches encroaching on the trail along 16-17 and 12-13. Ruth asked how you attack it without being covered in it?
- B. Tyson recommends:
 1. A Tyvek painter's coveralls, taped at the wrist and ankles
 2. Two layers of nitrile gloves,
 3. Tech-nu (or another oil-removing soap) on hand to wash with as soon as you are done.
 4. Throw out the overalls and gloves as soon as you are done.
- C. Clothing can be cleaned using Tech-Nu or other oil-removing soaps, if needed.
- D. A late addition by Andy: an oral antihistamine (Benadryl or Claritin) helps after the fact.
