3.03 League update

 - 2. Maximum 4 shooters/group. No minimum (honor system scoring).
 - 3. Individual scoring (not teams)
 - 4. Shoot one 15-target unit each week (alternating sides). Each group comes out on their own, so any time during daylight.
 - 5. Turn in score cards by the end of each week. Shoot at least 6 weeks out of the 7.

3.04 Outdoor Bale Replacement

- A. Targets 1 and 15 need super bales.
- B. Tyson brought up MoFoam Targets by Delta McKenzie as another outdoor option
 - 1. Shot-Blocker target line.
 - 2. Predator's Archery has some set up on their range. Holding up well
 - 3. Wall model is 42" x 18" x 18"
 - 4. Discussion of how they weather/degrade. Club members encouraged to look at them for future bale replacements.
 - 5. Do they strip glue-on heads (wood shafts)?
