Said they could be addressed safely, but he is not individually insured. He sometimes works for Tree Solutions out of Scotts Valley. Ed contacted Tree Solutions and they'll send an estimate once they are back in the office.
 - 1. Editor's note: we need the parks department arborist to approve taking out live trees or major branches.

 - 1. Discussed padding up the shooting position on 18.
 - 2. Discussed adding a platform in front of Target 19 (similar to Target 3).
 - 3. Added to the work party to-do list.
