3. Old Business

3.01 Range opening: May Update

- A. Outdoor Groups are still limited to 4 persons.
- B. The City has not started opening the gates yet. They now say it is up to us.
- C. Scheduled group events and classes are still suspended.
- D. Please wear masks when shooting the outdoor range and there are more than one family/isolation groups shooting at the same time.
- E. CDC guidelines still call for masks and social distancing outside if not all vaccinated. County Park guidelines allow for 15% occupancy for indoor Parks and Rec venues. However, remember there is NO ventilation in the indoor range. I would suggest no more than 1 instructor and 4 guests with ALL wearing masks.

3.03 League Update

3.06 Carport for Picnic Area – **Tabled until Covid-19 Restrictions are lifted and we can work in a large group .**

- A. Finally measured it. Looking at 14-ft by 18-ft. May end up with 12 x 20 since that's a standard kit.
- B. Waiting for the park facilities to reopen before placing an order.

3.07 Pay Pal Update: We are starting to accept payments! An extra fee will be charged for using PayPal to pay club dues, but the price of shoots will stay the same.

4. New Business

4.01 Club Constitution and By-Laws Update Voting

- A. Erick supports voting YES for the new updated By-Laws and Constitution. Andy puts up for a vote.
- B. Don moves to accept the constitution as amended on April 13th. Mark seconds. 29 I's with one abstention.

4.02 Vote to pay Tim Chandler back for materials purchased to repair benches and reimburse Bonnie Terribilini for the extra cost of the bulletin board. Andy makes the motion, Gabrielle seconds. Four I's, one opposed, one abstaining. The importance of getting approval for larger purchases before they are made was briefly discussed, as this was an unexpected expense.

4.03 3D in the Redwoods Shoot, June 6th

- A. We will need a substitute treasurer for this event as Robyn will be out of town
- B. We are hoping to have food at this event, hamburgers and hotdogs should be manageable with volunteers. Gabrielle will manage registration, sales and food volunteers.
- C. We will need to mow the parking lot for this shoot, Mark suggested renting a brush trimmer, but David said he has one the club can borrow.

4.04 Gabrielle proposed renting another porta-potty for this summer from ACE Portables starting Friday, June 4 for 3D in the Redwoods and our other big events this summer. Including installation, removal, and weekly maintenance the cost would be \$201 for the first month and \$146 for every additional month. Bonnie moved to rent a unit for 2 months, Mark seconded, the vote passed unanimously. We will revisit keeping longer at the July club meeting.
