- 3. Old Business**
 - 3.1. Range opening:
 - 3.1.1. The gates are now open from noon to 4 on the weekends again!
 - 3.1.2. Outdoor Groups are recommended to be 4 persons or fewer.
 - 3.1.3. Scheduled public group events and classes are still TBD
 - 3.1.4. Indoor shoots: The CDC guidelines call for masks and social distancing both indoors and outdoors. If you are unvaccinated masks are your personal choice, if you are unvaccinated masks are required. There are a maximum of 12 people who can sign up for the Friday night shoots.
 - 3.1.5. CDC guidelines still call for masks and social distancing outside if not all vaccinated. County Park guidelines allow for 15% occupancy for indoor Parks and Rec venues. However, remember there is NO ventilation in the indoor range. I would suggest no more than 1 instructor and 4 guests with ALL wearing masks.
 - 3.1.6. Santa Cruz City Parks and Rec has Golf and Disc Golf open.
 - 3.2. Aloha 3-D Shoot, Sunday July 18
 - 3.2.1. Thanks to Gabrielle, Vati, Do and Jack for set-up and coordination
 - 3.2.2. We had 43 registered shooters, 23 club members, 20 guests
 - 3.3. League updates (Mark Hersey):
 - 3.3.1. Summer Outdoor league Sunday, July 11 – Saturday, September 18.
 - 3.3.2. There are 22 members and so far everything is going well.
 - 3.4. Carport for Picnic Area –

 - 4.3. Shared Adventures: When do we want to start back up? Aug or Sept. Third Saturday of the month from 10-12. September is preferred as it gives us more time to set up and find instructors.
 - 4.4. Hire someone to fix the drainage by the clubhouse: Marty and Gabrielle. We need to decide the best way to maintain the drainage situation, possibly a buried culvert? Dave Wallis, Gabrielle, Marty & Tyson volunteered to meet and make plans to bring back to club.
 - 4.5. Targets 2 and 27 need new bales, those could likely benefit from a large (48x48) bulldog: need new superbales and bulldog targets... target.
 - 4.6. The front gate is wearing out, especially the hinges. We are hoping to ask the city about getting a repair crew out there. The top pin is shearing through the metal and the entire gate is sagging. The back gate has also been getting stuck and was tightened. Appears to be the same problem as the main gate. Erick and Andy will contact the City to get them to look at them.
