Oct 3, Bad Boys 3D Shoot: 84 archers from all over the state.(24 SCA members, 26 from other clubs and 34 with no club affiliation. Oct. 2019 Bad Boys we had 53 shooters. June 2021 3D in the Redwoods we had 82 shooters) Notes for next shoot: We will need more score record slips made up and more scorecards for BBoB. We have plenty of the 1st place medals left and about 30 were handed out for this shoot. When the scorecards and score record slips are next printed they need updating. There was no BBR, and BH was on all, but is not a current NFAA bowstyle. We LOVE holding registration outside and it might be better for those PayPal transactions as a bonus. We had great volunteer help, especially impressed with Saturday and the clean up help, but could have used a few more volunteers at the food, club sales and scorecard/award stations between 11:30-2:00. For big turnouts we could use 2 parking attendant volunteers from 7:30-8:30am, with one making sure there are no big gaps in the upper lot. 3. Old Business

- 3.1. Range opening:
 - 3.1.1. The gates are now open from noon to 4 on the weekends again!
 - 3.1.2. Outdoor Groups are recommended to be 4 persons or fewer.
 - 3.1.3. Scheduled public group events and classes are still TBD
 - 3.1.4. Indoor shoots: The CDC guidelines call for masks and social distancing both indoors and outdoors. If you are unvaccinated masks are your personal choice, if you are unvaccinated masks are required. There are a maximum of 12 people who can sign up for the Friday night shoots.

- 3.1.5. CDC guidelines still call for masks and social distancing outside if not all vaccinated. County Park guidelines allow for 15% occupancy for indoor Parks and Rec venues. However, remember there is NO ventilation in the indoor range. I would suggest no more than 1 instructor and 4 guests with ALL wearing masks.
 - 3.1.6. Santa Cruz City Parks and Rec has Golf and Disc Golf open.
 - 3.2. League updates (Mark Hersey):
 - 3.2.1. Summer Outdoor league ended in September
 - 3.2.2. League party on Sunday, Oct. 17, held at the Sawmill in Boulder Creek
 - 3.3. Carport for Picnic Area –
 - 3.3.1. Tabled until Covid-19 Restrictions are lifted and we can work in a large group.
 - 3.3.2. Finally measured it. Looking at 14-ft by 18-ft. May end up with 12 x 20 since that's a standard kit.
 - 3.3.3. Waiting for the park facilities to reopen before placing an order.
 - 3.4. Discussion of Santa Cruz Archers Logo. Mark will lead this discussion. We are working on a google docs voting system, this would allow even people not at the meeting to still have a vote. All submissions are in, the google form for voting has been tested, all current members should be getting the form to vote on their favorite concepts. Please vote for your favorite CONCEPT (finished or not). The five top picks will be redrawn by graphic artists and then voted on to get our new club logo!

- 4.1. Note: The City Fire Marshal has closed all off-trail areas in City parks due to fire risk. The range use is not affected. The restriction will run until we get some rain. If you see someone camping, contact park rangers or the sheriff.

 - 4.2.1. 14 animals, marked distances, we aren't overtly promoting it but all are welcome, rolling start at 9, last arrow at 2. Group size is no longer limited.

- 4.3. Shared Adventures: When do we want to start back up? Third Saturday of the month from 10-12. We will have to cancel on October 16th as we don't have any available instructors.
 - 4.4. City has some money to start fixing the drainage by the clubhouse. Coordinating with them - Erick.
 - 4.5. Target 2 needs a new bale, it could likely benefit from a large (48x48) bulldog: need new super bales and bulldog targets.
 - 4.6. City is looking at the gates, putting signs up on the golf course to keep wayward archers from being hit by golf balls on the fairways and from entering the course in shooting lanes.
 - 4.7. Preregistration for large shoots using PayPal. Pre Registration is being considered over paypal as the signal at the range is so poor, but there is a concern with refunds. We may be able to have people preregister on the website without payment through google forms. We used to have people pre register by mail, but it was largely unsuccessful.
 - 4.8. Set pricing for large shoots (3D in the Redwoods and BBB) - \$25 for an archer seemed a bit high. We raised the price on the shoot to account for the increased cost to us for using paypal. For future shoots we are going to decide to keep it at 25\$ or decrease to 2019 prices. We did increase the cost for members paying their yearly dues with paypal to 105\$.
 - 4.9. Proposal to hire a painter to take doors off hinges & repaint them along with donation box to match gutters. Bonnie is getting quotes.
 - 4.10. Elections for the 2022 Board of Directors. If you are interested in a BOD position or one of 4 member at large positions please let Erick know. Elections will be held in November.
 - 4.11. Regional 450 Round in November 7-15
 - 4.11.1. Need to set dates, times and limit for inside sessions.
