4.1. Range opening:

4.1.1. The gates are now open from noon to 4 on the weekends. Outdoor Groups are recommended to be 4 persons or fewer.

4.1.2. Scheduled public group events and classes are still TBD

4.1.3. Indoor shoots: The CDC guidelines call for masks and social distancing both indoors and outdoors. - 4.1.4. CDC guidelines still call for masks and social distancing outside if not all vaccinated. County Park guidelines allow for 15% occupancy for indoor Parks and Rec venues. However, remember there is NO ventilation in the indoor range. I would suggest no more than 1 instructor and 4 guests with ALL wearing masks.
- 4.2. BOO Shoot, October 31
 - 4.2.1. We had about 25 archers, made \$200
 - 4.2.2. Thanks to Erick for helping with set-up, and Henry for helping with take-down
- 4.3. League updates (Mark Hersey):
 - 4.3.1. Winter indoor league is being considered, depending on COVID restrictions. We are going to return to holding league as a group, on one or two days a week, so will decide in January 2022. On hiatus for the time being.
- 4.4. Carport for Picnic Area –
 - 4.4.1. Tabled until Covid-19 Restrictions are lifted and we can work in a large group. Plan to get the posts set so we can finally order the thing.
 - 4.4.2. Finally measured it. Looking at 14-ft by 18-ft. May end up with 12 x 20 since that's a standard kit.
 - 4.4.3. Waiting for the park facilities to reopen before placing an order.
- 4.5. Discussion of Santa Cruz Archers Logo. Mark's item
 - 4.5.1. The top five designs have been chosen! 52 people responded. We will vote as a club between the top five choices, check your email!
