1. Opening Items

 - 2.1.2. Great turnout at the Look What I Got For Christmas Shoot, thank you Andy for setting it up and to everyone who showed up and shot.
 - 2.1.3. BMB and Predators are Co-Hosting with USA Archery the USA Traditional Archery Championships July 29-31 at Kirigin Cellars. This event is open to all traditional archers. Lots of very different events: 100 yard shoots, 200 yd cloud shoot, and more.
 - 2.1.4. The City reported and cleared a couple down trees on the entrance road.

 - 2.2.1. State Indoor being held at our range on Jan. 8 and Jan. 16, 2022. You have to preregister at the CBH website and pay when you shoot. The signup for line assignments has been sent out in an email. 1/8 at 10AM and 1PM, and 1/16, same times.
 - 2.2.2. There is meant to be an outdoor club shoot on the 9th, but we need to know if there is interest to shoot and volunteers to set up new targets. Discussed and decided to pass this month due to wet trails and State Indoor the same weekend.

- 2.6. Outdoor Range Captain – Andy Sterbenz
 - 2.6.1. Rain results:
 - 2.6.1.1. We've had more rain so far this season than the total for the previous winter. It takes about three weeks after it stops raining for the runoff to subside.
 - 2.6.1.2. The bank erosion at Target 18 is slightly larger but still passable.
 - 2.6.1.3. There's new bank erosion/slide next to Target 9 (not affecting the trail but could undermine the hut if it grows)
 - 2.6.1.4. Standing dead trees are dropping limbs. Look up as you walk the course for snagged branches.
 - 2.6.1.5. Living trees growing towards the light tend to topple over, particularly in the wind. Henry added that erosion around the roots is a proximate cause, so report that if you see it.
 - 2.6.1.6. Several small rock slides to be cleared if they block drainage paths.
 - 2.6.2. Work Party Report
 - 2.6.2.1. Multiple small chores in December: fixed roofs on Target 1 and practice 25 and 30. Added the sway brace on 28. Replaced the bow tree on Target 3.
