- 3.1. Range opening:
 - 3.1.1. Scheduled public group events and classes are still TBD, Shared adventures and the beginning archery lesson are canceled this month as we still aren't in a covid safe position to hold them.
 - 3.1.2. Indoor shoots: The City guidelines call for masks and social distancing both indoors and outdoors. We had a maximum of 12 people who could sign up for the Friday night shoots, which was changed to 4 people at the January 4 club meeting. We have added two other nights to keep the 12-shooter total (Thursday and Saturday).
 - 3.1.3. Until the COVID-Omicron surge passes, please wear a mask while on the indoor range.

 - 4.2.4. Motion by Don to budget \$1700, second by Mark. Passed unanimously.
 - 4.3. Friday Night Shoots - Temporary COVID expansion
 - 4.3.1. Shoots will be three nights per week (Thurs, Fri, and Sat) for 300 and 450 Rounds until we can have 12 shooters inside the indoor range at one time. Need to hold a club vote. One night per week per person, sign up online. CANCEL if you can not make it.
 - 4.3.2. Motion by Don to retify the Board's action, second by Andy. Passed unanimously.
 - 4.4. Mark would like to buy a BLOCK brand target to try on the indoor range (either one 4'x4' or two 2'x4") to see how it compares to the Bulldog targets.
 - 4.4.1. Motion by Bonnie to approve \$1400 purchase, second by Don. Passed unanimously.
 - 4.5. Discussion of moving the pencil sharpener, or moving the hanging tools to facilitate access.
 - 4.6. Need to buy more spray glue. Motion by Andy to spend \$200 on glue. Second by Mark. Passed unanimously. Marty to make the purchase.
