3. Old Business

- 3.1. Range opening:
 - 3.1.1. Scheduled public group events and classes are still TBD, Shared adventures and the beginning archery lesson are canceled this month as we still aren't in a covid safe position to hold them.
 - 3.1.2. Indoor shoots: The City Parks has updated their guidelines. Masks MUST be worn for using indoor venues, regardless of vaccination status, but indoor venues are all open. (Yes, this is more restrictive than the State and County guidelines).
 - 3.1.3. Friday night shoots were discussed:
 - 3.1.3.1. Based on the Parks Dept rules, we should require masks indoors.
 - 3.1.3.2. Friday night shoots can go back to >4 persons. Attendance before COVID was typically under 10 persons.
 - 3.1.3.3. The sign-up system would not be needed with unlimited shooter slots, but those wanting to shoot for scores like knowing there will be at least three people there before they drive down for the shoot.
 - 3.1.3.4. Motion to go back to Friday night shoots on Fridays, no limit on the number of shooters, signing up is recommended but not required. Moved by Andy, second by Mark, passed 8-2-3.

 - 3.6.1. Erick talked with Becky at Shared Adventures Paralympic Sport Club and they would like to resume Archery in April. Depending on Covid status we will set-up outdoors at either the practice range and or in front of the clubhouse on the lawn for their shooters. Shared Adventures needs to reacquire their gear from somewhere in Boulder Creek.

- 3.7. Target Animal Order
 - 3.7.1. After replacing inserts and looking at all the animals, we need to order inserts for: fox, boar, mountain lion, and both strutting turkeys.
 - 3.7.2. Would like to order a second boar and a coyote. Maybe replace one skunk.
 - 3.7.3. Andy to get the price list from Rinehart this month and come back with the cost and weight for the big ones (elk, moose, bigfoot)
- 3.8. Updating the Range Rules Sign (4 x 8 white sign)
 - 3.8.1. Approved last meeting. Waiting for the order to come in.
 - 3.8.2. Will set the new posts in April.

4. New Business

- 4.1. Gabrielle proposes we purchase new lapel pins with the new logo on them for upcoming 3D shoots. We only have 9 with the old logo left. We have plenty of awards left for our 2022 3D shoots. We have 145 patches with the old logo and over 100 decals.
 - 4.1.1. Discussed replacing medals for shoots. Still have a 1-2 year supply so not yet.
 - 4.1.2. Cost estimate for 200 logo pins was \$298. Discussed placing a bigger order.
 - 4.1.3. Motion to budget \$500 to purchase new logo pins. Moved by Andy, second by Marty, passed unanimously.
- 4.2. Robyn proposes the club create an online apparel “store” through CafePress, Tee Spring or Squad Locker for our members to be able to order new logo club gear. We will create a few items, hoodies and zip up sweatshirts, mens and womens t-shirts, hats etc and members can go online and order the colors, sizes and styles they like.
 - 4.2.1. General approval. Robyn to research more details.
- 4.3. Robyn proposes the club buy the current stock of old logo club gear from Gabby to make sure she gets her money back and that the club uses its own funds to purchase future gear such as pins, stickers, mugs etc.
 - 4.3.1. Note: Gabrielle had purchased some of the higher-cost items in the inventory (shooter shirts, hoodies), so when they were sold the Treasurer had to then pass the payment through to her. This would make the club the owner of all the merchandise in stock.
 - 4.3.2. Bonnie moved we budget \$1600 to buy out the logowear stock. Second by Mark. Passed unanimously.
- 4.4. Erick is meeting with Miles from Delaveaga Park Maintenance to go over some issues at the range the City wants to discuss. Hopefully drainage.
- 4.5. In-Person Club Meetings. Discussed going back to in-person club meetings. Several members expressed discomfort with meeting indoors at the range due to poor ventilation. Will keep meeting on Zoom.
