- 4.1.2. We are canceling the service with *United Site Toilet Services* and switching to *ACE Portables service* in any case. We are now set up for cleaning the old unit every 2 weeks for \$110/ month starting May 19 and will have a second standard rental unit starting May 12 for \$145 per month and every week cleaning. Gabrielle plans to meet the driver on Wed. 5/4 for the last *United Site* visit, to get the gate key back. Robyn, this should be the last charge date for the club by *United Site Services*.
- 4.1.3. Renting an ADA portable with hand wash unit would be \$255/month but cleaned WEEKLY. Need to find a home for the old unit and then make the swap.
- 4.1.4. Gabrielle will have ACE Portable sign a key agreement when they drop off the unit and get the gate key..
- 4.2. July 9th, SC Parks and Rec Day. We are hosting a “get to know archery” event at the range. Two different lessons, tables with club members bestowing the virtues of archery to the general public.
