1. Opening Items

2. Officer Reports – briefly state successes and challenges.

2.1. President – Erick Sturm

- 2.1.1. BOD met on Aug 11 to discuss two construction projects at the range. 1. Fix indoor range drywall and insulation, 2. New animal shed deck. Project 1 passed unanimously. Project 2 was approved to \$4100 with a new bid with one abstain vote. The contractor only guaranteed his prices until Aug 20 so that was the reason for the BOD meeting.
- 2.1.2. Thank you Robyn and Bonnie for the Night Shoot on Sept 3. It was a fun shoot.

- 2.2.1. Next club outdoor, Sunday 9/11. Any volunteers for target set up or will it need to be canceled?
 - 2.2.1.1. Discussed and decided to cancel due to two conflicting shoots (State 900 and Salinas Island Shoot)
- 2.2.2. 13 SCA entries at **Regional 900, BMB**. We came in third for points, but overall we are still the leading club. BMB and KMA are closing in on us. Visit the MTBA website, which has been updated. Gabrielle became the webmaster recently.
- 2.2.3. Note that if you wish to shoot the **State 900** you MUST pre-register and pay at the CBH website. BMB hosts Sept 10&11 and Salinas Sept 18. For scores to count you must show your current NFAA, CBH or USA Archery membership.

- 3.5. Picnic area carport
 - 3.5.1. Tyson received a bid of \$3,706.85 from American Carports, Inc. for a 20'x12' standard roof structure, however could not get in touch with the company to go forward. Gabrielle will make a report at the next meeting.
- 3.6. Hiring a contractor for building work
 - 3.6.1. Robyn/Mark met with a contractor last week. Expect his pricing later this week.
 - 3.6.2. Items were repairing drywall on the indoor range and addressing the animal shed deck.
 - 3.6.3. After meeting on site with Alan (contractor), Andy, Marty, Mark & Robyn, revised the animal shed plan to install a new door on the scoreboard side, and then remove the narrow deck facing the practice range. We'll need to put in a short block retaining wall to protect the slope once the deck is removed.
- 3.7. Trading blanket (Gabrielle)
 - 3.7.1. Would we like to offer one indoors during Boo Shoot, 10/23? Gabrielle would take items to display and sell for club members OR club members could bring that day to make actual in-person trades with others.
 - 3.7.2. No objections raised to holding it on 10/23.
- 3.8. Unofficial World Archery Event (Marty & Mark?)
 - 3.8.1. No movement on this item. Will remove it from the agenda.
- 3.9. Arrows order status

Tyson said he would order 6 dozen full length Warrior 700 arrows for club use. The order was placed. Waiting for them to arrive.

 - 4.3. Review ACE Portable Service services and charges.
 - 4.3.1. Per Robyn- **we pay 265.13 per month. The breakdown is 145.00 rental and service for Ace porta potty. 110.00 for weekly clean out of our owned porta potty. 8.00 fuel surcharge. Tax 2.13
 - 4.3.2. Coming every week to clean both toilets. We asked them to come every other week. They are only charging us \$265 every 4 weeks.
 - 4.3.3. Do we want the rental toilet removed mid-October or keep year round? No decision made.
 - 4.3.4. Discussed getting an ADA unit (rental) to replace the old blue porta potty. Gabrielle will get pricing.
 - 4.4. Do we want to start the Club Lessons on the third Saturday again? If yes, cost per person/family?
 - 4.4.1. Discussed availability of instructors. Will send out an e-mail blast to see how many instructors would be interested, and revisit next month. Only staffing 12 sessions/year.
 - 4.5. We should discuss opening public events again.
 - 4.5.1. The website currently says everything is still members only...prospective members only option at this time is to attend a work party as their club event. I was contacted by 3 interested parties who were having trouble finding an event to attend per the website's current status.
 - 4.5.2. Outdoor events have been open for the last year. The website needs to be updated.

- 4.5.3. Discussed opening indoor events as well. This is just removing the members only language from the website, not advertising outside of the website/bulletin board. Consensus was to reopen all events.
- 4.6. Do we want to start in person meetings again?
 - 4.6.1. Motion by Robyn, second by Gabrielle, passed 7 yes, 1 no, 4 abstain.
- 4.7. Hoping we can make an updated orientation binder and have it available in the clubhouse so that board members besides Andy can offer orientation classes. Thank you so much Andy for doing this for so long...hopefully other board members can step in to help and we can offer the class more than once a month.
 - 4.7.1. Henry will email the Powerpoint to Andy. Andy will update as needed. Will circulate the revised version for board review.
- 4.8. Mark recommended purchasing two more Bulldog targets and an archery net to replace the carpet behind the target wall. Idea is the use the Bulldog targets in front of the target stands (bottom 2-ft)
 - 4.8.1. Tyson pointed out that the Bulldogs aren't stout enough to stand on, so not a viable option. Will need to consider an alternative (hay bales remain an option).
 - 4.8.2. Mark moved we spend up to \$500 for an archery net backstop (Bearpaw dense material). Second by Marty, 11 yes, 0 no, 1 abstain. Tyson recommended we see if we can order it through predators before buying on-line.
