

## Santa Cruz Archers October 2022 Meeting Minutes

### 1. Opening Items

- 1.1. Meeting Called to Order at 7:30 pm [in person, with the actual gavel].

### 2. Officer Reports – briefly state successes and challenges.

#### 2.1. President – Erick Sturm

- 2.1.1. Thank you to all those who came out and helped at the MeOne Foundation event on Sept 18. We taught archery to a lot of people and everyone had a great time.
- 2.1.2. Suspended Member: In 2019 Denise Barr was suspended from the SCA and all club events for 5 years ending Oct 1, 2024. She began showing up to club events in mid 2022 and reverted to the behavior that ended up in her suspension. Denise is not allowed at any SCA sanctioned event. If she shows up and will not leave, call the SC PD.
- 2.1.3. Thank you to everyone who helped out with the Bad Boys of Branciforte shoot this past weekend. We had 52 shooters from all over the state show up.
- 2.1.4. In the event we have more trees down on the range please let me know ASAP as the City is willing and able to help us remove the trees.

#### 2.2. 1st VP – Gabrielle Garrett

- 2.2.1. 10/9 Outdoor Field/Hunter. Volunteers to glue or hang on 10/8 would be appreciated. Is anyone coming? Same day as SFA Bug Shoot.

Discussed and decided to cancel this month's shoot.

- 2.2.2 The material cost of putting up new paper targets is about \$35.00 per outdoor round, which does not factor in wear and tear of bales and wood huts, target pins, scorecards used, etc. This is a FYI, in answer to questions about whether we are charging enough for club shoots. The current fee is \$3 per person.

  - 2.5.1. Income was \$130.00, Expenses were \$6011.44. The club is solvent.
  - 2.5.2. Note that these totals are for September. The shoot was October income.

  - 2.6.1. The Rinehart order isn't in yet, so the Critter Factory gorilla, elk and bear got to play again.
  - 2.6.2. The gorilla and bear suffered significant injuries and were retired. The elk will be repaired this weekend and see more shoots.

- 3.2. Me-One Camp Weiser, 9/17
  - 3.2.1. We had about 24 archers and 7 volunteers (a much easier ratio than previous years)
- 3.3. Shared Adventures Summer Camp, 9/18. Camp was postponed due to rain. New date is October 16. See Erick, Volunteers needed. Location is Camp Harmon in Boulder Creek.
- 3.4. Boo Shoot, Sunday, 10/23
  - 3.4.1. 14 animals, rolling start
  - 3.4.2. Set up at 7:30. Range open around 9:00
  - 3.4.3. \$10/per adult, \$5 for kids, peewees free
  - 3.4.4. Gabrielle will be manning the "Trading Blanket" indoors during and after shoot. Members can bring archery items to sell or trade that morning. Knives and hunting gear are also acceptable. Will also have club logowear for sale.
- 3.5. Regional 450 round (hosted at SCA)
  - 3.5.1. November 5-6.
  - 3.5.2. Pre-registration is at the MTBA website homepage for all 3 locations.

- 3.5.3. Help will be needed to run lines and make sure all rules are being followed. Limit of 10 per time slot. We currently have no more than 4 per time slot.
- 3.5.4. As of 10/4 we have 14 sign ups for our range and 12 SCA entries out of 54 entries total. Many are signing up with 2 or more entries per person.
- 3.6. League Report
  - 3.6.1. Fall indoor league: 9/25-12/18 (12 weeks)
  - 3.6.2. Sign ups still open. We have 20+ participants so far.
- 3.7. Picnic area carport (Gabrielle)
  - 3.7.1. Still looking at options. Andy will coordinate with Gabrielle.
- 3.8. Hiring a contractor for building work (Mark/Robyn).
  - 3.8.1. The deck was removed and the new door installed on the side of the building.
  - 3.8.2. The need for only one Club POC needed for this. Too many folks giving directions once he was on-site.
- 3.9. Arrows order status (Tyson)
  - 3.9.1. No update.
- 3.10. Review ACE Portable Service services and charges.
  - 3.10.1. Per Robyn- \*\*we pay 265.13 per month. The breakdown is 145.00 rental and service for Ace porta potty. 110.00 for weekly clean out of our owned porta potty. 8.00 fuel surcharge. Tax 2.13
  - 3.10.2. Replies from ACE: Cleaning of existing blue toilet *without* a rental unit will be \$75 per flush out. Rental of an ADA 7'x7' toilet with NO wash station and weekly flush out would be \$225 every 28 days. We would need to remove the old toilet ourselves beforehand.
  - 3.10.3. We are renting the standard unit through Thursday, 10/27. That would be a good day to bring in the ADA unit if chosen. Do we want the ADA rental year round or keep our owned unit to pay \$150-\$300 for 2-4 flush outs every 28 days?
  - 3.10.4. Discussed replacing the blue unit with an ADA rental and decided to keep the existing blue unit but pay for weekly servicing. Can re-evaluate this periodically.
