1. Opening Items

- 2.1.3. The BOD held a meeting to discuss increasing club dues. The BOD voted to raise dues to \$80 for Working members and \$200 for non working members. Working members will be given quarterly updates to ensure they get their 16 hrs/year in. If hrs are not in by Dec 1 then said member will owe the club \$120 to pay for their non working membership.
