  - 3.13.1. Went through the spending records for 2021 and 2022. Major expense areas were range supplies, the port-o-lets and hiring a tree service.
  - 3.13.2. Will need to do a deeper review of the range supplies and recurring charges.
- 4. New Business
  - 4.1. Proposed hosting the NFAA Summer Outdoor Field and/or Target League, June 4-August 27 (12 weeks). If we do, it will mean getting a \$25 rebate per entry and making up targets more often during that time (already restocked). All must

It was decided to only host the NFAA outdoor field league this year as we are not yet set up for a Target league, but not to publicize outside of the club.

- 4.1.1. Don moved, we host the NFAA field league, second by Andy. Passed 13-0-1
  - 4.2. Hiring help to get the range ready for inspection is really critical. Mentioned by Bonnie, not discussed.
  - 4.3. Need to fix the water line to the clubhouse before the 3D in the Redwoods. Andy and Marty will look at it Saturday. (DONE soon after)
  - 4.4. Robyn- I would like permission to purchase a Cosmic Archery range kit from Spider Archery. The \$300 Range kit includes 2 black lights, Cosmic Archery Banner and 20 black light targets. My goal is to throw Cosmic Archery Party novelty shoots every couple months. This would happen at the indoor range. Think black lights, glow necklaces, music, disco ball, pizza and "mock tails". Basically an archery rave and tons of fun!
  - 4.5. Bonnie moved approval, second by Mark, passed unanimously.
  - 4.6. Mark - Hiring CCC to do range work. They do nothing small! You get a full crew (10-15 ppl) for 4 days, Mon-Thur. Cost approx \$15K. There are two possibilities for grants based on the type of work being done. Many gov approvals to receive grants but the club does fit the necessary categories (non profit, city park, trail access, etc). Suggest small working group if we want to pursue.
