### 3. Old Business

- 3.1. 3d In the Redwoods
  - 3.1.1. We had 71 registered shooters and 69 scores were turned in. 54 registered with traditional bow styles (recurve and longbow) and 16 registered to shoot compound. Last year 43 shot traditional and 24 shot compound bow styles. We had 68 entries in 2022.
  - 3.1.2. Thanks to the crew for set-up, cooking, registration, clean up and weed whacking.
  - 3.1.3. At the end of the shoot we have nearly run out of 1st place medals and will need a new design for medallions next year.
  - 3.1.4. Comments received: Loved the food, course laid out well, distances provided good challenge and were laid out well. Loved the weather. Beautiful course. Complaints: Some of the compound archers were using rangefinders while others were not, which might have affected their scores. We said no rangefinders on the flyer.

  - 3.2.1. Two intro classes for the general public. No more than 15 students per class.

- 3.3. Beat the Heat Trad Rendezvous 7/16/23
  - 3.3.1. Range closed for set-up on 7/15/23
  - 3.3.2. Mike Fassio coordinating this event.
  - 3.3.3. Publicity is out now with a revised flyer, including online pre-registration and PayPal links.
- 3.4. Tabled until later: BBQ/Picnic Area cover scheduling. Ready to order a 10'x16' Verona single **carport kit from Home Depot for \$2,195**. Would be delivered to the store for FREE pick up in 2 weeks from the order date. (Gabrielle)
- 3.5. Tabled until Erick talks to Miles: Pothole, erosion repairs - permanent or temporary fix? What will the City do?
- 3.6. To be worked on this summer: Skid steer rental (Mark) A Tool Shed, Bobcat T450 w tracks (Info, no action)
  - 3.6.1. Rental Pricing: Daily- \$460, Weekly- \$1,440, Monthly- \$3,590**
  - 3.6.2. Need drier ground and a capable towing truck.
  - 3.6.3. Goals: Open up parking lot (remove berms, push back brush). Potential fire road repair/clearing. Any other earth moving jobs?
- 3.7. Tabled item: Mark - Hiring CCC to do range work. They do nothing small! You get a full crew (10-15 ppl) for 4 days, Mon-Thur. Cost approx \$15K. There are two possibilities for grants based on the type of work being done. Many gov approvals to receive grants but the club does not fit the necessary categories (non profit, city park, trail access, etc). Suggest small working group if we want to pursue.
  - 3.7.1. Erick volunteered to help with the grant request.
- 3.8. Phone repair update
  - 3.8.1. Still not fixed. The City met with ATT at the range today. Work scheduled to begin next week.
- 3.9. AED Update
  - 3.9.1. Still hasn't arrived, was back ordered but shouldn't be longer than 4 more weeks.
  - 3.9.2. Looking at offering CPR Certification at the range. \*The cost for up to 8 people to be trained in Adult First Aid/CPR/AED is \$1,124\*\*; each

additional person would cost \$107. This total cost includes our \$268 onsite delivery fee for one training class; any additional training classes would incur \$268 fee per day. The cost for up to 16 people to be trained in Adult First Aid/CPR/AED is \$1,980\*\*; each additional person would cost \$107. All training classes include the following: 2-year certification. Free digital training material. Free digital certificates for your employees

- 3.9.3. Discussed looking into local course options. May be easier to go to the instructor's facility.
- 3.10. Update on "reserve study" (Don)
  - 3.10.1. Went through the spending records for 2021 and 2022. Major expense areas were range supplies, the port-o-lets and hiring a tree service.
  - 3.10.2. Will need to do a deeper review of the range supplies and recurring charges.
- 3.11. Wood stove replacement status (keep on agenda?) Agreed to table until next year. New units cost from \$3000 to \$5000
  - 3.11.1. If anyone sees a used stove for sale, let us know.
- 4. New Business
  - 4.1. The club will soon be out of second place ribbons, low on third place ribbons. Request to reorder and update our stock with the current club logo. The cost is .64 for 6" long ribbons or .74 for 8" long ribbons. Minimum order 250 of each (which will last a very long time). Got a quote from Crown Awards for 500 ribbons: \$478.47 for 8x2" and \$423.61 for 6x2". They are nice quality like our current 7" ribbons with the old logo design. (Gabrielle)
    - 4.1.1. \$500 budget moved by Andy, second by Tyson, passed by all.
  - 4.2. Shed for our new Target Archery rounds and stands.
    - 4.2.1. Andy priced them online. Would be \$350 to \$500, depending on the model. Would need to add a wood floor under it.
    - 4.2.2. Gabrielle moved a budget of \$1,000. Don offered an amendment at \$800. Lower budget passed 9-2-2. Followed by an alternate idea of attaching a storage shed to the front corner of building. Much handier location.
  - 4.3. The July meeting falls on July 4th. Do we want to move it or cancel?
    - 4.3.1. Discussed and decided to cancel the meeting. Next meeting will be 8/1/23.

- 4.4. Shared Adventures is Canceled for July. It falls on the set up for Trad shoot and is also on the day of their "Day at the Beach" so we will resume in Aug.
  - 4.5. As of July 1, GreyBears will no longer accept cardboard for recycling. TBD if the landfill still accepts it for recycling.
  - 4.6. Need instructors for the Beginner's Archery Classes in July, August and September.
  - 4.7. Tyson pointed out that the narrow bulldog targets won't work for 11 and 21 since they are fan positions and the bulldog targets have an internal plywood frame. We have three MoFoam targets donated for use on #21, and two older ones on the indoor range. Suggested we buy a third for the outdoor range use.
    - 4.7.1. Andy moved we spend \$350 for a third MoFoam target, second by Tyson, passed unanimously.
