4. New Business

4.1. Shall we support the CBH/SAA Big Game Club again this year by purchasing a \$100 Reverse Blind Raffle ticket? Last ticket drawn can win up to \$10,000.

4.1.1. Andy moved we buy one ticket, second by Mark, passed unanimously. A check was written and Gabrielle will mail it to Karen Keating and keep the raffle ticket for the May 26 drawing.

4.2. 3D in the Redwoods on Sunday, June 2

4.2.2. Publicize and get registrations started now. We have the online form and Mark added the PayPal payment link.

4.2.3. We are low on 1st place medals, but have new 2nd and 3rd place ribbons. Vati has provided a design idea for the new medals. An order of 150 medals should last us 4 or more years.

Based on past numbers we can expect 65-80 or more for this shoot and up to 130 for the July 3D. Unanimous approval and Erick has already agreed to set it up.
