- 3.2. Sunday, July 21 Beat the Heat Traditional Rendezvous
 - 3.2.1. The updated flier and link to pre-register is on the SCA website .
 - 3.2.2. Erick secured the Taco Truck food service for this event. Yay!
 - 3.2.3. Awards ordered, planning committee is at work on making it even better than last year. They will need lots of setup help on July 20 for a reverse course, 30 targets and lots of signs.
