New Archers at Range (ed.)

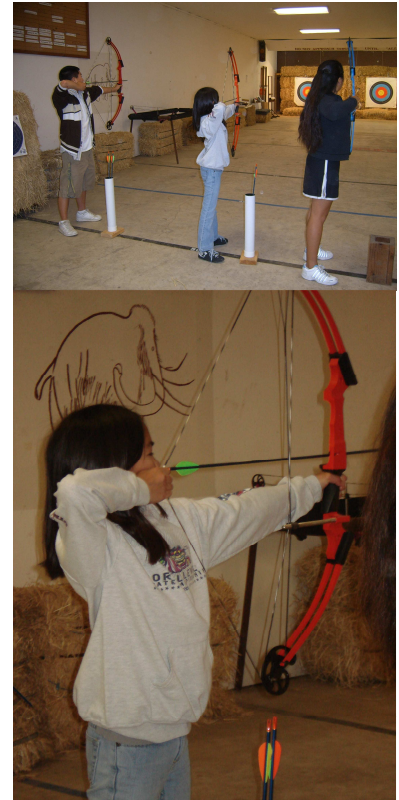
On Saturday morning, June 23, our club entertained 5 families (25 people) from the "Sunnyvale Home Group" of Orchard Valley Christian Church. This was their first planned group outing. In the group were several who had limited experience in archery but most were new to our sport. I borrowed some of the Archery-In-The-Schools equipment set from John Sutton of the Black Diamond Foundation. The Mathews Genesis bows

require no setup and adapt to any draw length making outfitting new archers much easier than setting up a bunch of recurve bows. In addition, the arrows are all the same, and, while not optimally spined for the bows, just sticking any three in a ground quiver saves a lot of setup time.

Ralph and Dianna Reader graciously agreed to help with the coaching which allowed us to handle 3 new archers at a time after I gave the introductory safety instructions provided an overview of archery form while demonstrating. During the demonstration, of course, I put three arrows dead center in the spot (right, it could happen). Coupled with the extreme patience demonstrated by our guests, the system worked.

Nearing the end of the event, we asked Wayne Reader, our resident National Champion, to stick a few arrows in the center of the spot as a demonstration of his "just-aim-and-pull" technique. Everyone was suitably impressed. I would have liked a few robin-hoods but he is overly protective of those expensive arrows.

Everyone seemed to enjoy their time at the range and appreciated the opportunity to learn about something new. As coaches, we certainly extend our thanks to John Sutton for the loan of the equipment and to the "Sunnyvale Home Group" for their patience and interest, both of which helped us run the event very smoothly.
