The **Outdoor** for June will be held at Mt Madonna. I is the Regional outdoor. While I will be unable to attend, I think it's a good idea for those that attend to get a car pool together.

Range Closure (ed.)

We are informed by the Santa Cruz City Parks Department that the project to clean the lead out of the pistol range was approved. The pistol range is the fenced in area you walk past between the parking lot and the indoor range.

They will start work between now and mid June. We will be getting more information shortly.

Please note that the range will be closed for approximately 4 weeks during the time the work is going on. There will be many large trucks on the road and some heavy equipment working in the area. In addition there is apparently a risk of inhaling lead dust which should be avoided.

We will provide more information, such as the precise start-of-work timing of the, when it becomes available.

Once the closure starts, the regularly held shoots will be suspended until the range opens again. This includes the Redwood Coast 3Ds.
