### Meeting Minutes: Sept 2, 2008

#### President's Report:

[\*Editors scoring note: The stumps are door shims that are about 1 1/2" wide and are stuck in the ground (except for one target where they are actually in a stump). If your arrow hits and damages a "stump" you get a point. There is a 3/8" hole in the stump, if you slip your

arrow in the hole without damaging the stump you get a point and a "hole." As you might guess, there are few holes recorded.]
