Old Business

1. New member Joseph Lucia would like to cook for the next outdoor shoot. He's set up to cook for large events. He'd like to serve Jambalaya on one day and shrimp etouffee on the other. Prices will be reasonable. Randy moved approval, second by Jerry. During discussion, all agreed that we still need burgers or hot dogs for the kids. Motion passed many drooling voters to none.

2. City Parks and Recreation Memo of Understanding update. The agreement is at the City waiting on their signature.

3. Roof repair update. Brian's crew was working on the roof today. They ended up replacing the plywood sheets along the lower edge of the roof. They are now putting the roofing on. Henry moved that we increase the roof repair budget by \$1500 to cover the extra materials. Seconded by Randy. Passed all to none.



4. Update on the new long-wearing target faces. They have been on the indoor range for about a month. Those shooting fast compound bows say the material melts onto the carbon shafts. Henry stated that the colors don't stand out the way the blue on the paper targets do (a combination of the reflective material and the lighting). Consensus was that we will probably not be ordering more of these.

5. Shared Adventures, a local non-profit organization that provides outdoor recreational activities for people with disabilities, will have their first archery event at the indoor range at 10:00 a.m. March 24. Instructors and volunteers, please arrive by 9:00 for setup.

New Business

1. New member introductions and voting. Six new members: Tess Goodwin, Matt Haines, Alex Brunette and Rafael Granados and his sons. Vote in unanimously.

2. Super-bales. Curtis at Predator's called to see if our club would like to order super-bales since Black Mountain is placing an order. Henry has had two members ask him to order a bale for home use. Discussion of what targets need repair/replacement followed. Consensus was that 6 bales would be a year's supply. Randy

moved we order 6 with a budget of \$500. Second by Andy. Motion passed many to one.

3. Randy moved that we budget to advertise the Bad Boys of Branciforte shoot in the CBH newsletter. Second by Henry. Discussion of budget, decided that we want 1 full-page ad and one ¼ page, total budget \$225. Motion passed all to none.

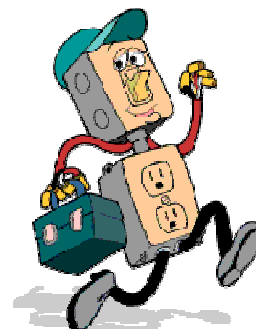
Old Business

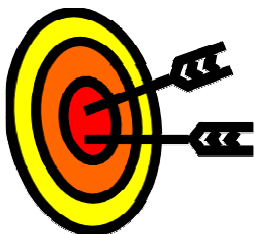

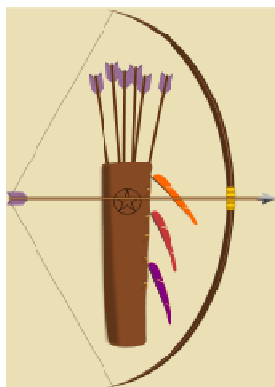
