



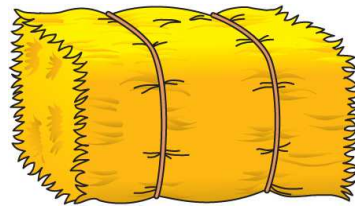

### Old Business

1. Work party planning commences, and there is no paucity of projects. We need to replace the indoor range target bales with our new super bales, and move the indoor bales to the outdoor practice range. Need a hand rail on the bridge on 16, and maybe new bridge on 27 and 28, and the walkway between 21 and 22 needs to be repaired or re-done, perhaps a retaining wall. Andy will check out the bridges and walkways. Work party is scheduled.

2. Gabrielle has black (dark blue? The club secretary's eyes are going) club logo hats, t-shirts, and ladies' fleece vests, all of high quality at reasonable prices, see her after the meeting.

3. When nominations or volunteers for club officers are mentioned, the meeting gets very quiet.
