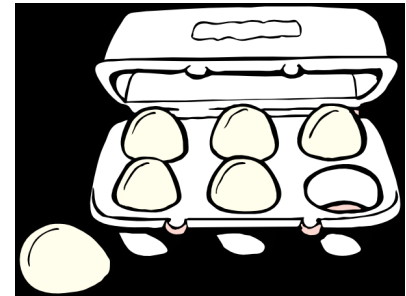
Work party January 4

President's Report (Mike Tracy)
No Report.

1st and 2nd Vice President's Report (Henry Bertram)
Shared Adventures sent us a thank you letter. The Cabrillo College surplus archery equipment was nearly worthless, and we should not buy it.

Secretary's Report (Steve Andrews)

Club is solvent, no major issues.

Outdoor Range Captain's Report (Andy Sterbenz)
Thanks to the work party that replaced super bales on the indoor range and cleaned up the outdoor shooting lanes. Reminder that we are having a 14 animal (in festive hats) unmarked 3D shoot on Saturday, 12/28/13. Andy cut some stencils for target faces. The results are hanging on the practice range. Andy repaired target frames on 12, 27, and the 30/35 practice target. The bottom front rail was shot through and breaking. In the future, we need to install fascia boards in front of the structural boards to catch arrows.

Reminder about the gates. If you open the front gate for a scheduled or informal event, remember to open the back gate as well.

November is done, December waits for the slacker secretary to furnish the minutes.

Key Master's Report (Randy Redmond)

Randy provides written estimates to change locks and keys, and recommends estimate #10. There is also a problem with the new locks the city puts on the gates. They are keyed the same, but until the locks have been worked for a while, our current generation of keys do not seem to work. Keys made a while ago work fine. (Pattern Drift?) Estimate 10 addresses the fix, so when the city puts a new lock on the gate, the member's key will function. A few recently made keys have not worked in the new locks. Long discussion about keys and alternatives and club history and relationship with the city and tax status and club rules. Will vote in old business. Randy also would like members to donate cardboard egg crates so his spouse can make more firestarters for the club.

Would the city be willing to give us the combination, thus saving us the expense of changing out the keys? Mike will research this.

3. Parking will be a problem on Sunday, 12/8 due to the outdoor club shoot and the MTBA Regional Indoor Shoot. We will close the range to the public that day.

4. Ben and Henry have made progress on the update and clarification of the new member introduction process. They welcome all input and assistance. Patterned after the Scotts Valley Sportsmen, a list of ideas to join so far:
