Membership Chair/Newsletter Editor's report (Lynn Rollins)

Web Master's report (Alex Viera)

Not present.



Old business

1. Long discussion and comments on the proposed membership rule changes and application of present club rules. Some members feel these changes and stricter adherence to the present rules will stifle club growth. Some feel these steps are destructive. Some feel non-working members should not be separate from working members. Some feel that sponsors are not needed. Some feel the board should not be making these decisions, and members

must remind the board that these decisions must be brought to the membership to be voted on. Some members feel that the membership chair's new member packet is well done and enough. Some members feel these steps are adequate and necessary. Vote called, new member rules passed and take effect next month.

2. Indoor bow rack refit tabled until next month's meeting.

3. Joseph moves, Jerry 2nds that we pay \$75 for a load of firewood. Unanimous approval.

4. The portable light for the portable potty fell in to the hole, and no one is willing to get it out. In progress.

5. Roof has some leaks that should be addressed. Wood has some rot. Brian has been getting some bids, around \$9,000. Some members feel this is a lot, can we mop and kettle? A little more discussion, someone will call Matt Rosso.

6. We need to get rid of the old bales. Mike says the old bales are still good for traditional equipment. Joseph moves, Henry 2nds that we have \$200 available to remove the bales, one way or another. Many yes, 1 abstain, no noes. Go get 'em.

New business

1. Is there interest in having a swap meet on a couple of weekend days of the year? Yes there is. Gabrielle and Joseph will meet with Mike after the meeting to discuss.

2. Should there be an arrow limit during indoor range shooting practice? If someone has 10 arrows and someone has 30 arrows, 10 arrow person can wait for quite some time. Discussion ensues. 5 arrow limit? Five arrows can take a long time. 3 archers plus on the line would be when these rules would take effect. Do not want a time limit. 2 archers left, when majority of archers are done, they must stop. This is getting complicated. Range master's duty to call last arrow? No voted action.

3. What would it take to fix the website? We don't know.

4. What do we do if we find a tree across the access road? Is there an emergency protocol? Tabled for next meeting.



5. Do we need a sign to regulate cell phone usage. Some members feel they are intrusive, some feel they are a necessary evil so they can get up here to shoot. Some members feel that respect for the sport does not involve cell phones. Some members feel we need to be in contact. We can control our members, we cannot control the public. Denise moves, Brian 2nds that we make a cell phone courtesy sign. 8 yes, 8 no, 11 abstain. Mike invokes president's role to break ties, votes no. 8 yes, 9 no, 11 abstain, motion fails.

6. Many new members.

- Joe has been shooting for 3 years, shoots compound, has a sponsor and has attended the new member class, would like to be a working member.
- Nick started shooting 21/2 weeks ago, lives nearby and would like to join as non-working.
- Katie is new to archery, although she shot as a kid, shoots a recurve, and would like to be a working member.
- Chris has been at it a couple of months, shoots recurve, and would like to be a non-working member.
- Mason has been shooting a couple of weeks, would like to be a working member, and shoots recurve.
- Will shot as a child and has picked up a longbow, would like to be a working member.
- Jenny took Henry's class and shoots recurve.

- Wendi shoots a recurve and took Henry's class.
- Gabriel is a lifelong hunter and has picked up a bow. Is here to check out the club.

As is our tradition, we vote to accept these folks into our club. Unanimous yes. Welcome. Be sure to subscribe to the club mailer on the website, this is the best way to get information on the club. Working members will be called the day before a work party.
