Important Note: As of Nov. 1, 2017 the NFAA eliminated Longbow with wood arrows, BowHunter and BHFSL as separate bowstyle divisions. If you shoot Longbow with wood arrows you will now be competing as Traditional (Recurve & LB together) for all State and National tournaments. These 3 divisions are still valid for club and regional tournaments however.

Old Business:

1. Boo Shoot Novelty, Sunday 10/29
 - a. 24 archers and really good cookies
 - b. Thanks to Belle, Rob and Tyson for set-up and clean-up

2. Regional 450 round on Sunday, 11/5
 - a. 15 archers (12 in a.m. and 3 in p.m.)
 - b. Made \$117.50 for the club.
 3. When do we want to schedule a work party to tackle the indoor bales? Mark suggested Saturday, 12/2 (the next regular work party). Mark will rent a lift for bale stacking.
 4. Range distance markers: Marty had an example out by the animal shed. This style is more durable than the version previously discussed and approved (June 6, 2017, we approved a budget of \$900). 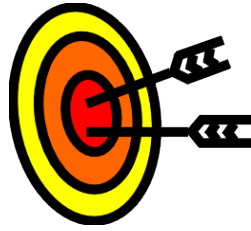
