BBQ social follows every Critter Getter

Earn blank leather “scalps” or discs for hitting targets. Each primitive archer receives 2 blank shells, longbow archers get 1 blank and recurve archers get 0 blanks at the start of the shoot. Archers earn one disc for each hit at a total of 14 targets. Trade in 4 blanks for one embossed disc. Trade in 10 embossed discs to get a forged brass dabloon! Prizes at the end of year. Cost: \$3 for members, \$5 for guests.
